❖ **Placement Status at IGDTUW:**

- For the Batch 2022, more than 116 companies visited the campus with a total number of 829 offers. More than 271 Summer Internship offers were rolled out for third year girls (i.e., passing out next year) and 95 offers for six-month internship for fourth year girls.
- Students bagged international offers, and have been offered a highest package of Rs. 1.2 Crores per annum by Amazon Dublin. Further, two students were offered the highest Internship offer at Facebook London, with the whooping stipend of 4.2 Lakhs per month.
- At National level, the highest CTC bagged by the students has been to the tune of Rs. 55 Lakhs from Adobe and Highest Internship package of Rs. 1.6 Lakhs per month from Uber.
- The average salary for these pre-placement offers has been Rs. 30 lakhs (Approx.) per annum.
- The Placement Season for the batch 2023 commenced with resounding success, witnessing the presence of 128 companies on our campus and resulting in an impressive total of 766 offers. 322 internship offers were rolled to batch 2023, out of which 227 students were given the Pre Placement offers.

- (i) The Department of Training and Technical Education (DTTE), Govt. of Delhi has issued the Expenditure Sanction of Rs. 49.92 Crore and one third amount *i.e.* Rs. 16.64 Crore as first Instalment to the Chief Project Manager, DTTDC However the amount is yet to be released by DTTE to DTTDC.
- (ii) After several rounds of detailed presentations by the Architect Consultant appointed by DTTDC, the detailed design of the Hostel block for construction of "Basement + Ground + 7 Storeyed structures" was approved by the University.
- (iii) DTTDC has informed that the approval of Delhi Urban Art Commission (DUAC) and Delhi Fire Services (DFS) has been obtained. The architectural consultant has applied for following approval at MCD and awaiting the
 - (a) NOC from Heritage Conservation Committee (HCC).
 - (b) National Monument Authority (NMA).

Further after getting above approvals, the tendering process for construction of the Hostel will be done by DTTDC.

Agenda Item No. 3.06 To apprise the Planning Board regarding the Status of New Campus of IGDTUW at Narela, Delhi

The Planning Board was informed that IGDTUW has been allocated a plot spanning 19.98 hectares for the establishment of the permanent campus of Indira Gandhi Delhi Technical University for Women (IGDTUW) in Narela. IGDTUW officially took possession of this land on October 19, 2022.

Furthermore, this matter was presented during the 15th meeting of the Building & Works Committee (BWC) on July 28, 2023. 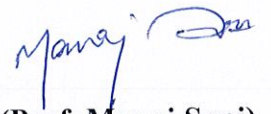
Various renovation works being carried-out at Kashmere Gate Campus, IGDTUW
