### Opening Remarks by the Vice Chancellor.

At the outset, Hon'ble Vice Chancellor, IGDTUW welcomed the esteemed members of the Finance Committee. She informed that in-spite of pandemic situation and lockdown, last quarter was filled with challenges, great initiatives, noticeable achievements, rewards and recognitions. She apprised the following achievements of the University:

- Awarded 2<sup>nd</sup> Rank by ARIIA: Indira Gandhi Delhi Technical University for Women has secured 2<sup>nd</sup> rank out of more than 650 universities in the category of Higher Educational Institutions Exclusively for Women in the award ceremony of Atal Ranking of Institutions on Innovation Achievements (ARIIA) Rankings 2020. Organized on 18 August 2020 by the Ministry of Education, the ceremony was graced by the Hon'ble Vice President of India
- University has received DIAMOND rating from QS I-GAUGE.
- University has been conferred ShrimatiSushmaSwaraj "STREE SHAKTI SAMMAN" due to its vision and commitment.
- University has received UGC 12B status.

- All the B.Tech and M.Tech Programs of the University are now approved by the AICTE.
- One of the M.Tech (IT) student, Ms Monika Kumari has received a prestigious FS-ISAC, USA scholarship of USD 10,000 to pursue research and development work in Information and Cyber Security. She is among the top 14 girls students selected for this prestigious scholarship across the world.
- The Department of Mechanical and Automation organized a National Conference on Innovations in Mechanical Engineering and Automation on 18<sup>th</sup> September, 2020 in an online mode which fetched overwhelming response.
- Admissions for all the Post Graduate courses and Ph.D programs for the Academic session 2020-21 were accomplished in the month of August 2020.
- A three weeks **Students Induction Program** was organized for all the new admitted students from 13<sup>th</sup> August to 28<sup>th</sup> August, 2020.
- Admissions process for the various Under Graduate Programs viz. BTech, B Arch, BBA is currently going on. EWS reservation as per Government guidelines has been implemented in all the Programs.
- One Week Faculty Development Program cum Workshop on Artificial Intelligence and Speech Technology (AIST) was organized from 17<sup>th</sup>-21<sup>st</sup> August, 2020 in collaboration with IBM and Anveshan Foundation as a prelude to the 2<sup>nd</sup> International Conference on Artificial Intelligence and Speech Technology which was held on 19-20<sup>th</sup> November, 2020.
